Trails and Rails Program: In cooperation with the National Park Service, an interpretive guide from the Jefferson National Expansion Memorial (consisting of the Gateway Arch, the Museum of Westward Expansion and St. Louis' Old Courthouse) provides a narrative on board the Lincoln Service (Trains 301 and 302) between St. Louis and Springfield, MO, daily through November 14, and between February 5 and March 27, Saturdays and Sundays. Chicago Airports

Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) rapid transit trains provide frequent service to O'Hare and Midway Airports. Blue Line trains to O'Hare leave from the subway station at the corner of Clinton and Congress Streets, two blocks south of Union Station. Orange Line trains to Midway leave from the elevated station at the corner of Quincy and Wells streets, three blocks east of Union Station. Pay fare in CTA station.
